Lifegroup Questions - Vision 2020

Scriptures used: Acts 1:8; Romans 10:13-15; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4; 1 Peter 3:15; Colossians 2:6-7; Luke 10:1-3, 17, 21, 38-42; Hebrews 10:24-25; Ephesians 4:11-16

REACH

- To REACH often involves stretching. In which way is your faith being stretched presently? In which ways might it be stretched even further as you REACH your friends and family with the life-transforming love of Christ?
- Tamworth Elim Church is what it is today because faithful people down through the years have passed on their spiritual batons to the next generation. What legacy would you wish to leave?
- Steve suggested that we are called to be fishers of men, not keepers of aquariums. What do you think he was getting at?

GROW

- Read Colossians 2:6-7 what do you think it means to be "rooted and built up" in Jesus?
- Dallas Willard says that "Discipleship is the process of becoming who Jesus would be if he were you" what does this look like in your life?
- On Sunday Dan suggested three ways in which we can begin to think about our GROWTH in 2020 (Time with Jesus, Journeying with others, Stepping out in faith) which of these did you find the most challenging and why?

EQUIP

- Read Ephesians 4:11-16. What are the areas in your life that you feel you need more equipping in? This may be in matters of faith such as prayer or reading the bible, or matters of life such as wisdom, friendships, parenting or marriage?
- Who are the people that you 'do life' with? Do you have people in your life that you can have honest conversations with and that can support and encourage you? If not how might you go about doing this?
- Who can you reach out to? What ways can you reach out to those around you and better equip them?
